Breckenridge Public Utilities (BPU) has completed and submitted our service line materials inventory to the Minnesota Department of Health. The service line inventory is publicly available, and you can check the materials for your service line by visiting the Lead Inventory Tracking Tool (LITT) at https://maps.umn.edu/LSL/. To complete the service line inventory, our Utility solicited information from residents who were able to identify their own water line and BPU assisted others by performing physical inspections of all other water service lines in our service territory. After completing our inspections in May of 2024, our inventory contains 43 lead lines and 56 galvanized lines. These lines will be replaced in the coming years as monies become available from the state. The remaining 1331 service lines are either Copper or Poly and require no action.

#### WATER CONSERVATION

NEVER use the toilet to dispose of trash! The bathroom accounts for almost 70% of water usage in average homes

# DO YOU KNOW WHAT YOUR "AVERAGE" WATER USAGE IS? DO YOU KNOW WHAT IT SHOULD BE?

\*AVERAGE PERSON USES 2,000 GALLONS OF WATER PER MONTH\* Examples (usages all depend on age of appliances, length of shower, laundry loads per week, etc. the following are estimates):

2 Adults = 4,000 gallons of water per month

2 Adults + 2 Teenagers = 7,000-8,000 gallons of water per month 2 Adults + 1 small child= 5,000 gallons of water per month 1 Elderly Adult= Less than 1,000-2,000 gallons of water per month

#### <u>Test your toilets for leaks at least once a year—toilet leaks can be silent!</u>

A good way to check if your toilet is leaking is by putting food coloring in your toilet tank (A), wait 15 minutes—if it seeps into the bowl without flushing (B), then there's a leak that needs fixing. Replace the guts in the tank of the toilet or call a plumber. \*See photo for an example.

## DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR MAIN SHUT-OFF VALVE IS IN YOUR HOME IF YOU WERE TO

HAVE A LEAK? To locate the main water shut-off valve in your home, look for a utility space near where the main water line enters the home. Check near the water meter or along the perimeter of your home. \*See photo for example. Turn that valve to stop that water from entering your home & contact a plumber.
