### Crew Updates

Electric: Director of Public Services Crocker informed the commission that the electric crew is continuing work on HWY 75 tear out. Load management is up and running, and they plan on testing receivers later next week.

Water: Director of Public Services Crocker informed the commission that Water Foreman Jeff's crew is working on the pool and that the ponds opened up today for another release and bacteria samples go in tomorrow. Crocker also explained the leaks that happened at the pool and at Jefferson. James Finkral passed his CDL test and Mikayla Jensen passed her permit test.

Commissioner Larson questioned Director of Public Services Crocker on when jetting of lines is supposed to occur. Crocker advised that it is a yearly endeavor, but it has not yet occurred for calendar year 2024. Commissioner Larson had water backup in his basement and wanted to confirm if it was just him or if other citizens had called in. Crocker advised no other calls have occurred, Commissioner Larson said it is probably his home then.

### **Boring Quotes**

Director of Public Utilities Crocker presented to the commission two quotes for redoing wiring on city lights due to underground wiring failures.

Scott's Electric \$9.50 per foot TelCom Const. \$8.50 per foot

Director Crocker informed members that there are 6 areas that have been identified at an estimated cost of \$50,000.00. Crocker recommended that the low quote be accepted. Commissioner Summerville offered a motion to recommend to the City Council to accept the low quote from TelCom. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Karlgaard and carried unanimously.

#### Street Light Boring

This matter was tabled. No formal action taken.

#### Northport Addition Electrical Quotes

Director of Public Utilities Crocker informed the commission that this project will require electrical design work. He presented two quotes (one from DGR Engineering and one from Ulteig Engineering).

DGR came in at roughly \$10,300 and Ulteig at roughly \$34,000. No formal action taken as this was purely for informational purposes only.

Director of Public Services Crocker informed the commission of his upcoming MESERB meeting on June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> and discussed travel plans and for the commission's blessing to expense the trip. Commissioners had no problem with Director Crocker attending.
